Important to Remember... WEEKLY FAMILY ENVELOPE

This year, the "family envelope" will again be a clear plastic envelope so they can be wiped down before they go out and when they are returned. They will be going home TWICE A MONTH on a Tuesday with important communications between the school and parents. Our first weekly envelope is going out today, August 16th. Please take all contents out of the envelope, read the materials, sign the front of the envelope and return the EMPTY ENVELOPE the next day. <u>PLEASE DO NOT RETURN ANY</u> PAPERS, ETC. SENT IN THE ENVELOPE UNLESS INSTRUCTED TO DO SO.

ONSITE COVID TESTING

We will again be offering free COVID Testing on campus here at St. Louise. If you were in the program last year and want to continue for this year, you do need to re-register. I, if you are new to the program and wish to participate, you need to pre-register for testing. The website link is:

Testing will begin on Friday, Aug. 26th, in the parish hall and take place every Friday at 8:00 am. This weekly testing is a free program through Heluna Health open to all on campus (vaccinated or unvaccinated), which includes staff, students, and any parents who volunteer on our campus.

You only need to register once and each time you test, it will take no longer than 15 minutes. Students signed up for the program will be taken over to the Hall during the morning by a staff member to get tested. If you are a parent volunteer and want to get tested, you just need to go directly to the hall at 8 am. Results are generated and provided to both those that have been tested and the school.

Please note this program is free for all participants. Testing is not required, but highly encouraged.

DOCTOR'S PERMISSION FORM FOR MEDICATION

A Medication Permission form will be enclosed in the next family envelope on Aug. 30th. It must be used if your child needs to take medication during the school day. All medications must be brought to school and picked up by an adult.

The medication, accompanied by the form, signed by the doctor, must come in the original container specifying the name of the medication, strength and instructions. Medication <u>MAY NOT</u> come in envelopes, baggies or any other container.

PLEASE KEEP THIS FORM AT HOME so you can take it to your doctor when your child is sick. If you need another form, please call the office. All medications **MUST** be kept in the Health Room.

Medications, including Tylenol, cough syrup, cough drops, vitamins, etc. may not be given to a student by school personnel nor is the student allowed to have any of these medications in his/her possession unless this medical permission form has been filled out specifically stating this requirement.

Written Permissions...

For those children who walk to and/or from school, we ask parents to submit a written/typed note with your signature to the front office confirming that your child(ren) has/have your permission to walk home.

Also, if you need someone (other than those listed on your "Emergency/Disaster" forms) to pick up your child from school, please submit a written/typed note with your signature to the front office confirming that person(s) has/have permission to pick your child/children.

Please Note: Emergency lunches can be ordered after normal cut off time until 11:30 pm the day before service. See their website for options.

LUNCH/ITEM DROP OFFS

In order to assure safety for the children and to avoid classroom interruptions, "forgotten" lunches MUST be dropped off in the front office. Any other "forgotten" items MUST be dropped off in the school office—we will make sure the students receives it.

To avoid strangers on campus, we ask that NO UBER (etc.) deliveries be made to the school. We have had delivery personnel wander around campus trying to deliver pre-ordered lunches and this is a MAJOR safety issue.

Lunches MAY NOT be delivered to the lunch area. IN FACT, THE PRACTICE OF DELIVERING LUNCH SHOULD NOT BE FREQUENT! The office drop off should only be in case of an emergency

Please send lunches with your children in the morning.

AFTER SCHOOL DAYCARE PROGRAM

This will be provided after school hours. Ms. Chris Avila is the supervisor of this program.

Because of the option of After School Child Care, **NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED TO REMAIN AFTER SCHOOL UNSUPERVISED. NO STUDENT** will be supervised by the coaches **EXCEPT** those students on the team. This is for the safety of the children which must always come first! If a student is not picked up 15 minutes after dismissal, the child will be taken to the Day Care Program and you will be assessed & billed at the daily rate (Information of these rates can be found on the school website under the "Tuition & Fees" section).

All children must be picked up from Day Care by 6:00 pm. If you are late, a \$20.00 late fee for every 15 minutes will be assessed & billed through your Blackbaud Tuition account.

Please remember that your child will be released only to those you have designated on your contract, or by a signed note from the parent. We cannot release a child via telephone message.

We do have a telephone in the Day Care Room which you may use for emergency messages. The number is 626-332-2410 (after 3:00 pm)

There is adult supervision before school starting at 7:00 am in the 7th grade classroom.

Please do not drop off your children before 7 a.m.


BIKES ON SCHOOL GROUNDS
