DOCTOR'S PERMISSION FORM FOR MEDICATION

A Medication Permission form will be enclosed in next week's family envelope. It must be used if your child needs to take medication during the school day. All medications must be brought to school and picked up by an adult.

The medication, accompanied by the form, signed by the doctor, must come in the original container specifying the name of the medication, strength and instructions. Medication <u>MAY NOT</u> come in envelopes, baggies or any other container.

PLEASE KEEP THIS FORM AT HOME so you can take it to your doctor when your child is sick. If you need another form, please call the office. All medications **MUST** be kept in the Health Room.

Medications, including Tylenol, cough syrup, cough drops, vitamins, etc. may not be given to a student by school personnel nor is the student allowed to have any of these medications in his/her possession unless this medical permission form has been filled out specifically stating this requirement.

Written Permissions...

For those children who walk to and/or from school, we ask parents to submit a written/typed note with your signature to the front office confirming that your child(ren) has/have your permission to walk home.

Also, if you need someone (other than those listed on your "Emergency/Disaster" forms) to pick up your child from school, please submit a written/typed note with your signature to the front office confirming that person(s) has/have permission to pick your child/children.

DID YOU KNOW...

BE ON TIME!

It is important that students are on time for school everyday. When arriving late, every student must come to the school office for a late slip in order to be admitted to class

If your children arrive at school after the 8:00 bell (second bell) in the morning on their class Mass day, they will be considered late. We want students to be safe. A staff member will



be by the church crosswalk to give them a late slip & walk them safely to the church.

Please Note: Emergency Lunch orders need to be placed and paid for anytime between 9:01am until 11:30pm the day prior to service for Tuesday-Friday service days, and between 9:01am Fri until 11:30pm Sunday for a Monday service day.

LUNCH/ITEM DROP OFFS

In order to assure safety for the children and to avoid classroom interruptions, "forgotten" lunches MUST be dropped off in the front office. Any other "forgotten" items MUST be dropped off in the school office—we will make sure the students receives it.

Lunches MAY NOT be delivered to the lunch area. IN FACT, THE PRACTICE OF DELIVERING LUNCH SHOULD NOT BE FREQUENT! The office drop off should only be in case of an emergency

Please send lunches with your children in the morning.

AFTER SCHOOL DAYCARE PROGRAM

This will be provided after school hours. Ms. Chris Avila is the supervisor of this program.

Because of the option of After School Child Care, **NO STUDENT IS ALLOWED TO REMAIN AFTER SCHOOL UNSUPERVISED. NO STUDENT** will be supervised by the coaches **EXCEPT** those students on the team. This is for the safety of the children which must always come first! If a student is not picked up 15 minutes after dismissal, the child will be taken to the Day Care Program and you will be assessed & billed at the daily rate (Information of these rates can be found on the school website under the "Tuition & Fees" section).

All children must be picked up from Day Care by 6:00 p.m. If you are late, a \$20.00 late fee for every 15 minutes will be assessed & billed through your SMART Tuition account.

Please remember that your child will be released only to those you have designated on your contract, or by a signed note from the parent. We cannot release a child via telephone message.

We do have a telephone in the Day Care Room which you may use for emergency messages. The number is 626-332 -2410 (after 3:00 p.m.)

There is adult supervision before school starting at 7:00 a.m. in the 7th grade classroom.

Please do not drop off your children before 7 a.m.



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
