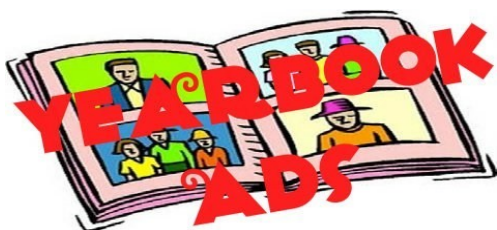
## Holiday Scrip News...

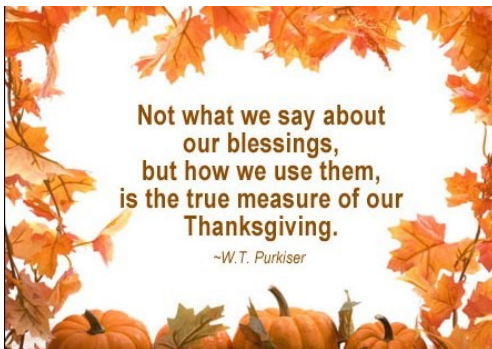
