Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe

Today, we celebrate the second Sunday of Advent. As we light the second candle, we reflect on this candle which symbolizes peace.

It is also around this time we celebrate two Marian Holy Days. Last Friday we celebrated the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. This week we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe. I think it is appropriate that we honor Mary during this second week of Advent, the week of Peace. (Pope)

St. Paul the 6th declared New Year's day, Solemnity of Mary Mother of God, as the World Day of Peace. This I believe there is synergy between Peace and Mary, Mother of God.

Pope Francis said on January 1, 2015, "At the beginning of this new year, we are all called to concrete works of peace: You don't get along with that person? Make peace. In your home? Make peace. In the community? Make peace. At work? Make peace." Describing Mary as the "queen of peace," the pope said that during her earthly life she knew difficulty, "but she never lost her peace of heart, a fruit of having abandoned herself with trust to the mercy of God. We ask Mary, our tender mother, to point the whole world to the sure path of love and peace."

In the homily delivered by Pope Francis on January 1, 2020, he said. ""Mary," he states, "is both woman and mother. This is what is essential. From her, a woman, salvation came forth, and thus, there is no salvation without a woman." Without Mary, God and humanity could have never become one. She "wove the humanity of God," as Pope Francis stated.

The Feast of the Lady of Guadalupe is joyously celebrated in Southern California, particularly in parishes with many Hispanic and/or Filipino parishioners. The traditions of the day migrated north from Mexico. As the patroness of the Americas, she is celebrated in both North and South America and every place in between! What surprises many is that on July 16, 1935, Pope Pius XI decreed the Virgin of Guadalupe of Mexico, "The [Heavenly] Patroness of the Philippine Islands."

This is a special Feast Day for "regular" Catholics because Mary appeared to Saint Juan Diego, a simple man, with the task of getting the Bishop to build her a shrine at the site of her visitation. Saint Juan Diego had no power. He had no money; he was not a gifted orator that could convince someone to do something he didn't want to do. And poor Juan Diego discovered that the first time he went to see the Bishop to relay Mary's message. The Bishop did not believe him and said to come back with proof that Mary visited him. Having failed, Saint Juan Diego went on his way. Now he was looking for a priest to administer last rites for his dying uncle.



On December 12th, Juan Diego was visited by Mary again. He told her of the bishop's answer, and she instructed him to gather roses and take them to the bishop as a sign. She also informed Juan Diego that his uncle would recover from his illness. Juan Diego found many roses on the hill even though it was winter. When he opened his tilma (cloak) while appearing before the bishop, dozens of roses fell out, and an image of Mary, imprinted on the inside of his cloak, became visible. Having received his proof, the bishop ordered that a church be built on Tepeyac Hill in honor of the Virgin. Juan Diego returned home and found his uncle's health restored. This story, more than any other, reflects Mary's love and trust in us. This is the Mary that we know and that we "ordinary" people can petition Mary for help

Recognizing the signs of physical abuse

Safe adults should be on the lookout for signs of physical abuse in children in their care. Some signs include frequent bruises or cuts, frequent and unexplained absences or injuries. Physical abuse can include hitting, kicking, shaking, or other forceful actions, resulting in harm or even death. Children who are suffering from physical abuse may be distrustful or reluctant to receive physical contact, and may dress inappropriately for the season, wearing long pants or long-sleeved shirts to hide injuries.
