COVID, FLU, & COLD REMINDER...

We continue to have an increase in sick children coming in to school. Most have been coughs and colds, however, we have had a couple of positive COVID-19 cases recently. If your child becomes ill, please test for COVID-19. A home test is sufficient.

Even if your child is negative for COVID-19, please keep your children at home until symptoms (fever, cough, sore throat, etc.) are better and children have been fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medicine. Remember, we want to lessen the spread of regular germs too. If your child does test positive for COVID-19, we ask that you please notify the school office at principal@stlouisedm.org.

If a positive child or adult has been on campus in the past 48 hours, the school will notify the community of a positive case via email. If your child is identified as a "close contact" you will receive a separate email. Close contacts can remain in school but will need to wear a mask for a period of 5 days while on campus (the school can provide masks). Symptoms should be monitored, and close contacts should test after day 5 of exposure.

We thank you for helping to keep our community safe and healthy.


The Archdiocese continues helping survivors of sexual abuse and their families
