

Understanding the VIRTUS® "Protecting God's Children" program

Child sexual abusers often target nurturing, child-friendly environments, where parents and participants assume that no one would ever want to harm a child.

Religious organizations are prime examples. The Catholic Church has adapted the VIRTUS® Protecting God's Children program to send a message to potential predators that child sexual abuse is not tolerated. Through this program, adults learn that through early identification, awareness, and education they can be "proactive" in protecting children and young people from child sexual abuse.
