ST. LOUISE ALUMNI SPOTLIGHT

Another St. Louise alumni highlight—The faith-inspired art of students from 12 LA Catholic high schools is being showcased at a special exhibit at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels. The exhibit will be up through April 30th.

Chloe Castillo (Class of 2021), Thomas Lam (Class of 2020), and Jaime Vasquez (Class of 2020) were three of five students chosen from Bishop Amat High School to have their artwork exhibited for six week at the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels as part of "The Robert Graham Memorial Art Show". Each piece of art includes a short write-up written by the student about what spirituality means to them.

The annual Robert Graham Memorial Student Art Exhibit was officially unveiled Sunday, March 19, at the cathedral. The exhibit features works of art from 60 high school students, who received a blessing and certificates from Archbishop José H. Gomez at the event.

The art exhibit celebrates the value that Catholic education provides to young people and its contributions to our Church, communities, and nation.

The exhibit is named after the late Robert Graham, a Mexican-born American sculptor of international fame who was based in Los Angeles. He died in 2008 and left behind a legacy in Catholic art, having created the Great Bronze Doors of the Cathedral among other notable public art displays. Since 2017, this program is curated by Noriko Fujinami, member of Fine-Arts Committee for the Cathedral and Robert Graham Studio Director.

<u>President</u>— This is a two year term. The President presides over monthly meetings and takes the lead on events, represents the school at the School Board meetings. The President works with the principal in coordinating meetings and any other business related to the Parent Club.

<u>Vice President</u>—This is a two year term. The Vice President shall act as an aide to the President, and in the absence of the President shall perform the duties of President. The Vice President shall meet periodically with the chairpersons of the Standing Committees appointed by the Principal; shall keep the Parents' Club Board informed of the activities of the Committees and keep the Committees informed of the actions of the Board. The Vice President must have held the position of Room Mother Chairperson, directing the activities of the Room Mothers.

<u>Incoming Development</u>—A two year term. Helps coordinate and run school fundraisers, such as the Box Tops program, the Ink Recycling program, restaurant fundraisers, etc. You will be an available active member in all Parent Club activities that may periodically arrive throughout the term and for the two year term; you will attend a monthly Parent Club meeting. 


