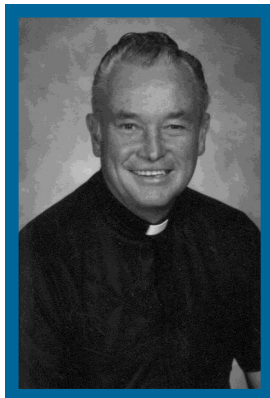

We owe much to Msgr. Pierce for all he did to make our parish, in his words, "second to none". Please remember Msgr. Pierce in your prayers this week.



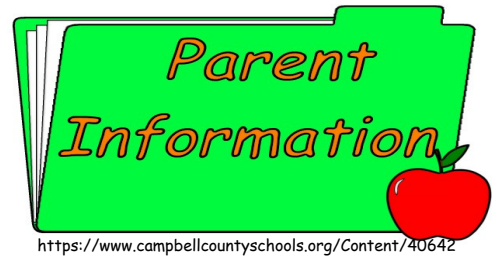
Make-Up Pictures...

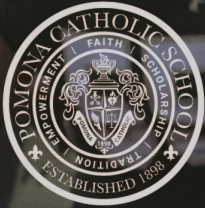

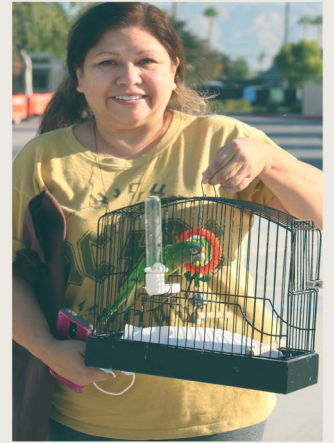
