ONSITE COVID TESTING HAS BEGUN!

We are happy to announce that our first week of offering COVID-19 testing on site went very smoothly!

Testing is held in the parish hall every Friday beginning at 8:00 am. This weekly testing is a free program through Heluna and Primary Health open to all on campus (vaccinated or unvaccinated), which includes staff, students, and any parents who volunteer on our campus. This program also satisfies the testing requirements for those who are in our athletic programs. If you wish to participate in the program, you will need to pre-register for testing by clicking this link:

You only need to register once and each time you test, it will take no longer than 15 minutes. Students signed up for the program will be taken over to the Hall during the morning by a staff member to get tested. If you are a parent volunteer and want to get tested, you just need to go directly to the hall at 8 am. Results are generated and provided to both those that have been tested and the school.

Please note this program is free for all participants. Testing is not required, but highly encouraged.

Great job everyone—We raised \$336 for our “Buck-A-Jean” Pink Day! Proceeds will be sent to St. Jude’s Hospital.



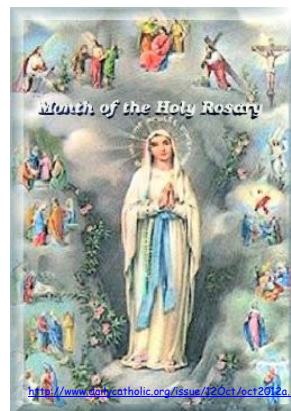
Half Day Reminder...

INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO RESERVE YOUR SPOT FOR THE PARENT SOCIAL IN THE “PURCHASE OPTIONAL ITEMS (SHOPPING CART) IN SMART TUITION

PLEASE NOTE: You MUST REGISTER AND PAY through your SMART Tuition account to reserve your spot.

Log into your SMART Tuition account - parent.smarttuition.com

(if you need help logging into your SMART Tuition account, please contact SMART at 1-800-468-8996)

- Select “purchase optional items” at the top of the screen
- “Select student(s)” in the middle of the screen
- Check the name of all students you wish to order for and select “go”
- Check all of the items you wish to order for each student
- Choose the quantity you wish to order for each student (please note your total amount below)
- Select “save”
- Consent to the agreement (this is a description of the shopping cart items you have purchased)
- Check “I have read the description of this item and agree to purchase” (you will have to do this for each item)
- Check “I understand that all purchases are final and non-refundable” (you will have to do this for each item)
- Select “agree”
- Select “continue”
- Click “pay now” (all shopping cart items are pay now items - they cannot be added to your SMART invoice)
- Choose account to be used for payment – you may use an existing saved payment method or add a new one (remember, convenience fees are added to credit card or debit card transactions)
- Select “checkout” - You can choose to print a receipt. This is the only opportunity to print the receipt.

Escalating red flags in an adult's behavior

In most abuse cases, the victim knows the offender. Offenders go to great lengths to ensure that they are not strangers, often spending months or even years hiding in plain sight. Parents should be aware of a few red flags that range from obvious to subtle, and usually indicate a more sinister relationship at work between an offender and potential victims. Some obvious signs include telling children dirty jokes or showing them pornography. More subtle signs could be an adult who wrestles or tickles often, wants to be alone with children, gives gifts frequently, or encourages children to keep secrets.
